XXIII INTERNATIONAL SHORT FILM FESTIVAL
Ravenna, 26 – 30 April 2022

The XXIII International Festival "Corti da Sogni - Antonio Ricci" is organized by the Circolo del Cinema Sogni - Antonio Ricci APS (hereinafter Circolo Sogni) in partnership with the Municipality of Ravenna/Department of Culture.

1. Conditions of participation

Short films produced after 1 January 2020 can participate in the selection.

Shorts already registered in previous editions cannot be re-registered, even if in a new version.

The duration of the shorts must not exceed 30 minutes

The accepted projection formats are: MP4 (preferred) .AVI; .MOV; MPEG4 H264; .MKV

The competition is open to short films shot in any format and from any country. Documentaries, industrial, advertising and propaganda films are not accepted.

The shorts in a language other than Italian must be subtitled in Italian or English.

2. Registration and selection

Registration can be done via Shortfilmdepot, Filmfreeway or Festhome:

The deadline for registration is February 14, 2022.

The registration costs of the shorts are as follows:

Registration starts: December 9, 2022

Earlybird deadline: until December 31, 2022 (5 euro/film)

Regular deadline: until January 23, 2022 (8 euro/film)

Final deadline: until February 14, 2022 (10 euro/film)

The following must be attached to registration:

- a short poster or photo of the short;
- a photo and the biography of the director (s);
- subtitle file (possibly in srt format) or dialog list with time code;
- upload of the short film (possibly without superimposed subtitles).

Each short film entered and selected for the competition cannot be withdrawn from the selection itself. Should this occur, the Festival Management reserves the right to take legal action to obtain compensation for any damages.

The selected shorts will be announced on March 27, 2022 on the website www.cinesogni.it.

3. Sections and Awards

- **SOGNI D'ORO:** international competition for fiction short films coming from outside Europe (prize and recognition of 500 euros);
- **EUROPEAN SOGNI AWARD:** international competition for the best European fiction short film (award and prize 500 euros).
- **GIUSEPPE MAESTRI AWARD:** section reserved for animated short films (prize and recognition of 500 euros);
- **MADE IN ITALY:** section reserved for Italian short films (prize and recognition of 400 euros);
- **FREQUENZE IN CORTO:** competition open to music video (award and prize 300 euros);

These prizes will be awarded by a jury composed by representatives of the artistic, audiovisual and academic world.

- **FILM SCHOOL AWARD:** competition open to categoria short films produced by a film school (award and prize 300 euros)
- **MITICI CRITICI:** (young jury) competition for short films characterized by themes or sensibility to young audience; the prize is awarded by a jury of student (award);
- **GREEN PLANET mention:** for the first time the festival will assign a special mention to the most deserving works in terms of environmental issues and sensitivities, which will be screened in a special event at the Arena del Sole in Lido di Classe.

The Festival Committee and the jury may assign some special mentions.

4. Processing personal data

Participants authorize the Festival Organization to process the personal data contained in their works and complementary material.

5. Television and internet broadcasting

By participating in the competition, the author authorizes the Circolo Sogni, free of charge, to reproduce and broadcast on television and internet sites, extracts of the shorts selected for the Festival. These extracts are limited to 10% of the total duration of each short and in any case cannot exceed three minutes. They can only be used in interviews and / or promotional or advertising announcements of the Festival for the current or future editions, for a period of one year from the registration of the short film on www.shortfilmdepot.com, <https://filmfreeway.com> or <https://festhome.com>

6. Archiving

By participating in the competition, the author authorizes the filing of the courts registered for the selection at the headquarters of the Circolo Sogni, who undertakes to catalog them and make them available for all screenings, events and broadcasts promoted by the same, for cultural and non-commercial purposes (unless otherwise expressly stated at the time of registration).

7. Authorization to screenings for cultural purposes

By participating in the competition, the author authorizes the Circolo Sogni to make the short films entered in the selection available for all screenings, events and broadcasts promoted by the same, for cultural and non-commercial purposes (unless otherwise expressly stated upon registration).

8. Guarantees

By registering the short film, the Circolo Sogni guarantees that all of the rights and authorizations necessary for the participation of the short film in the competing sections are held or have been acquired, as well as the uses granted to the Circolo Sogni under these regulations.

9. Unforeseen cases and disputes

Registration and participation in the Competition imply the unreserved acceptance of these regulations and the registration form. Circolo Sogni reserves the right to unsubscribe and take any other measures in the event of non-compliance with the regulation.

For any exception not covered by the aforementioned regulation, Circolo Sogni reserves the right to take definitive decisions.
